Job Context: Jago Nari Unnayan Sangstha (JNUS) was established in 2009 as an independent, non-profit and non-political women-led Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) in Ramu Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh. From its inception, JNUS has been working in both prevention and response to Gender Based Violence (GBV) especially violence against women and girls. The organization contributes to improve the conditions of the female victims and the youth in respect to human rights and justice. JNUS does have a strong advocacy network, collaboration with the community actors, enjoys high national and local reputation, and regularly undertakes initiatives along with other development partners.
